The theme, **"Onward and Upward"**, captured the remarkable achievement of 115 years of dedicated service. Our special guests included Ms. Rosie Allen-Herring, President and CEO of the United Way of the National Capital Area; Dr. Charlene Monk, Pastor, New Horizon Christian Faith Church; Dr. Carroll A. Our guest speaker for the occasion was the Honorable Rushern L. Baker, III, County Executive, Prince George's County, MD, who provided a touching tribute and testimony to the importance of care giving.

Since 1902, Stoddard has a rich legacy of providing quality healthcare services to the aging population in the Washington Metropolitan area. This vision began as a dream for a retirement home for Baptist ministers, their wives and/or widows. The initial funds came to Stoddard through the heir of Miss Maria T. Stoddard, a Washington philanthropist of the late nineteenth century. Since 1902, Stoddard has always been led by men and women of vision who have constantly increased the effort to serve the wider community.



Through Stoddard's current two entities of care, Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home and Stoddard Baptist Global Care, housing/medical care is provided in a home-like environment for over 400 elders who are unable to live independently.

Our goal is for both future and existing group of friends to be **"Recommitted"** to Stoddard's purpose of caring for elders, **"Reconnected"** in relationship with Stoddard and to **"Revere"** Stoddard as a prominent and necessary organization for elders and caregivers in the Greater Washington Area and beyond!

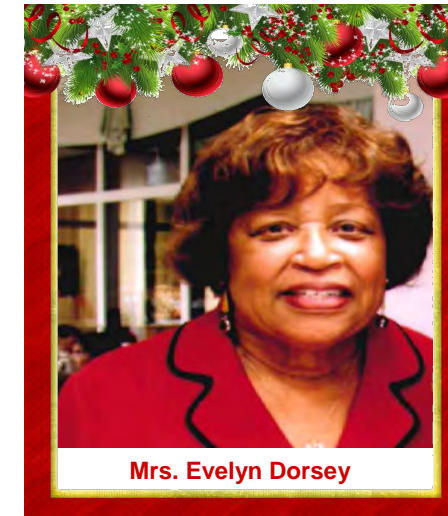

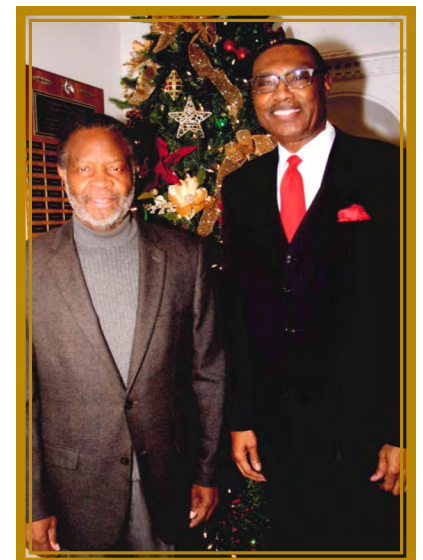
2017 ANNUAL HOLIDAY OPEN HOUSE

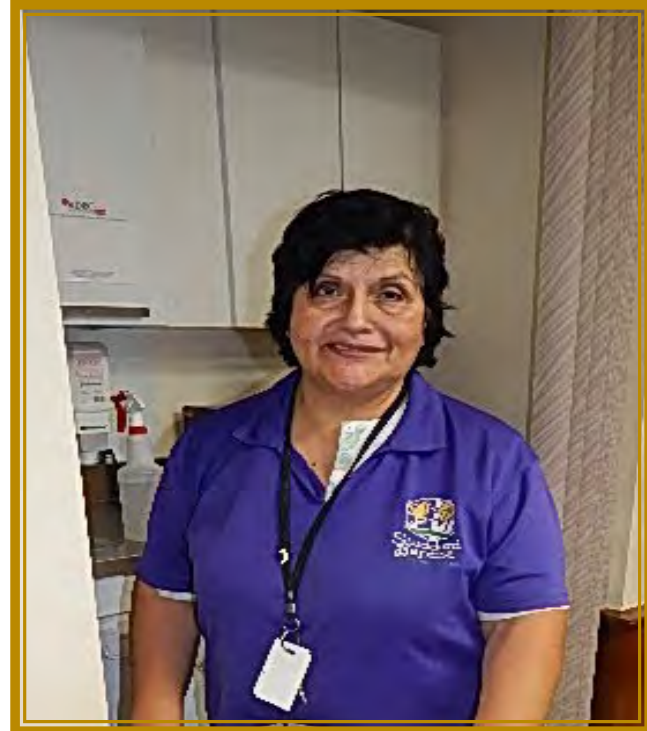
