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

The **Grand Opening of Stoddard Baptist Global Care's New Rehabilitative Therapy Program** was held on Thursday, April 27th. During this ribbon cutting occasion, participants were able to see live demonstrations of the therapy services that are provided with the partnership of Functional Pathways (FP). The FP Team was presented an award certificate for their partnership.

Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home and Stoddard Baptist Global Care are two of the many unique FP clients across the nation. FP's goal is to provide therapy services that exceed expectations through relationships, outcomes and innovations. FP provides physical, occupational and speech therapy treatment, which can help with all sorts of medical conditions that daily impact living activities such as eating, bathing, dressing, toileting, transfers and ambulation activities. FP's Physical Therapists work with the residents in training for increased mobility, gait, stability, posture and wheelchair positioning. Exercise programs are implemented to increase muscle strength, function, coordination and endurance. FP's Occupational Therapists provide education and training in such things as dressing, bathing, eating, grooming and other activities of daily living. Adaptive techniques or equipment to overcome physical barriers are recommended to maximize functional independence. FP's Speech Language Pathologists address communication and swallowing dysfunction. The treatment plan can include recovery of speech, language and memory skills. Activities for memory, orientation and cognitive abilities can be implemented practices that focus on restoring, compensating and adapting for underlying impairments and physical dysfunctions. Oral muscle strength and functioning is required for speaking and swallowing, as well as appropriate/safe diet recommendations that can be designed for individual needs.
