For the last 25 years, her work has focused specifically on care for the District’s senior populations at all levels of subacute and long-term care: skilled nursing, short-term rehabilitation, assisted living, long-term care and memory support. She has served in that capacity in three 5-star, long-term care communities where she demonstrated competence in maintaining regulatory compliance, systems development, policy interpretation and implementation, workforce development and budget management (including a \$3M renovation initiative). Her management philosophy embodies an intentional emphasis on compassionate customer service, communication, staff development and accountability for quality outcomes. In addition to nursing, Mrs. Savoy holds an undergraduate degree in Organizational Development and a graduate degree in Management. She has enjoyed membership and board-level participation in local and national associations.
